

Sources and Uses of Funds for Parking Permits and Fines

Parking Fines: Parking fines, without exception, may not be paid from any university account. This is to comply with the Directions of NSHE General Counsel as follows:

“Fines for parking cannot be charged to any System or UNLV account.”

Fines may be paid from agency accounts (Fund 2776) with the appropriate approvals. (Agency accounts are funded by non-university agencies and are not considered to be university accounts. We act only as banker for these accounts.)

Parking Permits: By previous agreement, university funds will not be used to pay for parking permits for faculty, staff, or students. Only certain grant accounts (2330-2399) if approved in advance may be used to pay for parking permits for faculty, staff, or students.

The fees for temporary parking permits for temporary passes, metered parking for special events, or other non faculty, staff, or student parking passes may be paid from non-appropriated accounts. (Appropriated accounts are accounts in funds 21xx. For example funds 2101 or 2105. Non-appropriated accounts are those accounts in all other funds. For example 2220, 2221, or 2330.)
